

Award for Excellence in Teaching High School Physics



Nominations are now open for a new award recognizing the efforts of Canada's innovative physics teachers.

The awards, to be presented annually in 5 regions across Canada, will recognize outstanding secondary school and CEGEP physics teachers and their commitment to:

- motivate students,
- develop innovative teaching methods,
- mentor both students and new physics teachers, and
- foster science related extra-curricular activities.



The award includes an educational grant that can be used to support professional development for the teacher or to purchase computer software, equipment or books for the classroom. One teacher will also be given the opportunity to participate in a 3-week physics teachers' symposium at CERN in July 2012.
